If you see someone on Twitter or Tumblr discussing “shipping,” don’t assume they’re talking about mailing a package. The term has taken on new life thanks to people, predominantly teens, using the word to discuss ideal relationships between fictional characters, celebrities, and even their own friends.



Shipping originated in the world of fandoms, which are groups of hardcore fans of movies, books, and television shows. According to the ridiculously comprehensive fandom slang guides of the internet, the word derives from "relationshipper," typically shortened to just "shipper." Relationshippers are people who care deeply about the romantic relationships between their favorite characters — and sometimes, celebrities or even the people in their own lives.

So instead of saying, "Romeo and Juliet are a perfect couple," a Shakespeare-loving shipper would say, "I ship Romeo and Juliet."

"To say, 'I ship that couple,' is a short way for someone to say that they believe in a couple, that they're rooting for them to succeed," Michael, my friend's 15-year-old brother who is a high school sophomore from New Jersey, told Tech Insider. "The term has evolved in teenage slang to become a widespread part of our vocabulary."

When you see someone talking about “ships” or “shipping” on the internet, there’s a good chance they’re not talking about seacraft or logistics. Here’s what a “ship” means online and how to use it.

Relation-ship

On the internet, a “ship” is often an abbreviated slang word for “relationship,” and it generally refers to a romantic relationship between two fictional characters. For example, if you’re currently watching *Titanic*, you might say “There’s a ship developing between Jack and Rose.”

“Ship” is also commonly used as a verb to show your support for a particular romantic pairing. For example, if you enjoy the chemistry of the leads in *Titanic*, you could say, “I ship Jack and Rose.” The word also communicates a sense of strong interest or affinity for a particular romantic pairing. It’s common to see people saying “this is my ship” about a particular pairing as a way to show strong support for it. This is similar to OTP, or “one true pairing.”

Before you start telling people you ship everyone, there are a few things you should remember. This is a very informal slang term and only makes sense to those active in internet circles. On top of that, in messages, it can very easily be confused for a boat or a package shipping service. Use it only when you’re being clear that you’re referring to a romantic pairing.

Here are a few examples of the slang term “ship” in action:

- “I ship Romeo and Juliet.”
- “Mark and Marlene make such a great couple! I ship them.”
- “Wow, I can’t believe Monica and Chandler ended up together. The ship has sailed!”
- “I really ship burgers and fries.”

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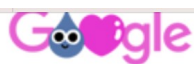

Looking for Tradition in a Modern Chinese Wedding

What happens when modern sensibilities conflict with longstanding customs?

Sitting shyly on her bed, surrounded by raucous wedding guests, the bride watched as her groom — a coworker of mine — knelt and prepared to kiss her feet. She offered up a few half-joking words of comfort. “Don’t worry,” she reassured him. “I washed them.”

It’s just one amusing moment in a day full of them. In this particular portion of the traditional Chinese wedding, the groom must fetch his bride from her natal family and bring her to the wedding venue. The bridal party typically prepares challenges the groom must overcome before they’ll let him take her away, such as hiding her shoes and forcing him to find them and put them on. In this case, the wedding party egged him into planting a kiss on his bride’s feet as he did so.

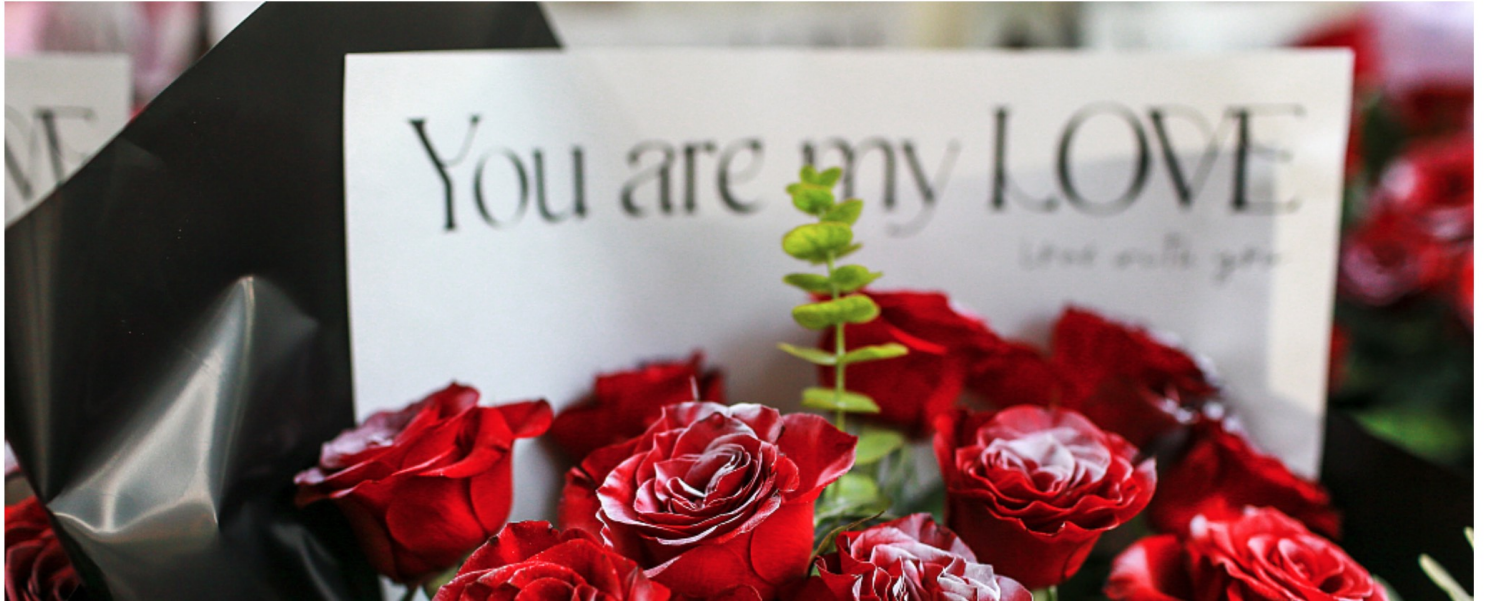
If you wanted to locate the source of these games in the Chinese canon, it would probably be the practice of *qinying* mentioned in the

Confucian classic "The Book of Etiquette and Ceremonial." Literally translated, it means "to welcome in person." A symbolic rite of passage, *qinying* — now more often rendered as *yingqin* — signifies the participants' changing social status as the bride leaves her natal family and joins the groom's family.

Alongside the **rising popularity** of *hanfu*, or traditional Chinese clothing, young Chinese are increasingly eschewing the Western-style weddings popular in recent decades for more classically inspired affairs. Like all weddings, however, these are a balancing act, as couples navigate a complex mix of formal rituals, often raunchy folk practices, and modern sensibilities.

Valentine's Day meaningless, but not harmful

Back to work after the weeklong Spring Festival holiday, many young Chinese people are making preparations for a romantic Valentine's Day on Feb 14. Given the younger generation's propensity to celebrate festivals with gusto, middle-aged and aged people would do well to not visit restaurants, bars, cinemas, dance halls and shops on Valentine's Day, because they are likely to be packed with young lovers.

Plus, many things will cost a lot more on Feb 14 than on normal days. For example, flowers, especially roses, could cost many times more.

Many young Chinese people embraced Western festivals, which made their life more colorful. But they couldn't see the invisible hand at work to make the Western festivals popular in the country.

The invisible hand is that of the business community which, by popularizing Western festivals, is boosting sales across different fields. During Christmas and Valentine's Day, outlets in shopping malls are decorated with, among other things, balloons, banners, cutouts of Santa Claus and lovers locked in a kiss. The festive atmosphere is palpable — with large, yellow billboards screaming "On Sale" outside many outlets.

According to an online survey by iiMedia Research, 72 percent of the people said Valentine's Day helps bring young lovers closer and strengthen their bond, with only 16 percent saying the festival is used by shrewd businesspeople to boost their sales and make higher profits.

Some netizens even accused the organizers of forgetting the atrocities committed by the Japanese invaders in China from 1931 to 1945, including the rape of innumerable women and slaughtering of about 300,000 Chinese people in Nanjing in the six weeks since Dec 13, 1937.

Following the criticism, the organizers cancelled the shopping gala.
